Permit Allocation Guidelines

Parking permits are allocated based on the number of employees listed on the business license. Each business is eligible to receive a number of permits equal to **150% of its employee count, rounded down** (e.g., a business with 1 employee is eligible for 1 permit; a business with 2 employees is eligible for 3 permits).

Super Permits

Fee: \$250 annually
Eligibility: Open to businesses or residents within the district
Restrictions: Not valid on San Dimas Avenue
Valid Locations: Only in the municipal lot off of and south of Bonita Ave.

Permit Parking Conditions **San Dimas Municipal Code Chapter 10.25**

Permit Display

Parking permits shall be displayed properly in the rearview mirror of vehicle. The City may also choose to link permits to license plate numbers, in which case permittees shall be required to clearly display their license plate rather than a separate permit.

Parking Prohibitions

Except as otherwise provided in this Chapter (10.25.030), it shall be unlawful for any person to stand or park a vehicle on any street or portion thereof in a Permit Parking District on the days, or during the hours, or for longer than the time periods established by resolution of the City Council without properly displaying a valid parking permit for such district. The prohibitions created by this Chapter shall not be enforced unless signs or markings giving adequate notice thereof have been placed.

Please acknowledge your understanding of the following prohibited acts by your initials:

1. *I understand, this permit provides exemption only from parking restrictions enacted pursuant to Chapter 10.25 Permit Parking Program of the San Dimas Municipal Code. All other parking restrictions remain in effect.*
2. *I understand, it is prohibited to buy, sell, rent, or lease for any value or consideration any Permit Parking District(s) permit except as provided in this policy. Upon the conviction of a violation of this subsection, all permit parking permits issued to or for the benefit of the Business License will be void.*
3. *I understand, any vehicle having a permit which is not properly displayed or a permit displayed in a vehicle not authorized to display such permit, will be deemed in violation of this policy. The fact that a permit has been issued to a business, but the permit was not properly displayed is not a defense or considered in determining whether or not a violation has occurred.*
4. *I understand, it is prohibited to copy, produce, create, alter or use any facsimile or counterfeit parking permit.*
5. *I understand, it is prohibited to falsely represent oneself as eligible for a parking permit or furnish false information to the Director of Public Works (or other authorized City representative) in an application for a parking permit.*

Compliance with other parking regulations; No guarantee of parking space

Nothing in this Chapter exempts a vehicle with a parking permit from complying with any parking rule, regulation, or restriction imposed by state law or any other Chapter in the San Dimas Municipal Code. A parking permit does not guarantee, nor reserve an on-street parking space. Possession of a parking permit pursuant to this Chapter does not allow overnight parking, which is governed by Chapter 10.24 of the San Dimas Municipal Code. The applicant agrees to comply with Permit Parking Conditions as set forth in the latest adopted policy.
