Election Night:

***PRELIMINARY RESULTS AND REPORTING WILL BE BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS***

In order to provide accurate and up to date results of the election, the public will be able to livestream election activity and retrieve results from the LA County Registrar of Voters link on the City's webpage. Typing in the City of San Dimas on the "Elections Results" page in the "Contest" box will take the viewer directly to a green bar graph of our races. For those wanting a detailed breakdown of voter activity other links are also provided on the "Elections Results" page (Statement of Votes Cast)

The 1st semi-official results of Vote By Mail ballots cast before Election Day are scheduled to be reported at approximately 8:30-8:45 PM on March 5, 2024. Second reporting results will be at 8:45-9:00 for Vote Center ballots cast before Election Day.

Post-Election:

Counting ballots and reporting results does not end on Election Night. All Vote by Mail ballots cast by Election Day and received within seven (7) days will be accepted, processed, and once verified, counted.

All Conditional Voter Registration (same-day registration) and Provisional Ballots cast on Election Day are processed and added to the tally once they are cleared.

The County plans to have the usual ballot counting/tally events throughout the rest of March on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays with new results posted online by 4:00 PM.

Certification:

1. On March 29, 2024 the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify results.

2. The City Council will certify the results of the election at the April 9, 2024 City Council meeting and the newly elected Councilmember will be sworn in. More details and information on this will be provided at a later date.
