# VOLUNTEER YOUTH BASKETBALL COACH DEADLINE TO APPLY: Open until filled

#### **GENERAL PURPOSE**

The City of San Dimas Parks and Recreation Department offers a basketball league for youth ages 8-14 that emphasizes teaching fundamentals, sportsmanship, teamwork and fun. The program runs from December until March. Coaches must be available for practices two days per week scheduled between the hours of 5:30pm-8:30pm and games Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (all times approximate). Additional hours for trainings and meetings as assigned.

Practices begin the week of January 9th

The duties listed below are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to this position.

- 1. Responsible for planning, organizing, and supervising basketball practices.
- 2. Responsible for the general safety and well-being of the children of the assigned team.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Previous coaching experience and the ability to instruct and work with children are preferred. Knowledge of the rules and regulations of basketball is helpful. Applicant must be 18 years of age or older and must have valid California driver's license and adequate transportation.
