RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PLAN CHECK SUBMITTAL GUIDELINES

(Includes New Single Family Residences, New Multifamily, Accessory Dwelling Units, Duplexes and New Mixed Use Projects)

SUBMITTAL PROCESS

- □ Site Plan/Cover Sheet showing street, all four property lines, type of construction, occupancy, fire sprinkler status (Y/N), outline of all structures, and location of proposed construction.
- **Floor Plan** show all door and window sizes and locations, label the use of and show dimensions of all rooms.
- □ Foundation Plan/Foundation Details
- □ Floor Framing Plan for multiple story buildings.
- Building Elevations & Sections
- Framing Details
- Roof Framing Plan
- □ *Electrical Plans* meter, switch, outlet, and light locations, and PV panel location as required by T-24 energy calculations.
- □ Mechanical Plans HVAC equipment location, return air location and size, and thermostat location.
- D Plumbing Plans fixtures location, sewer lateral size, slope, location, and gas line isometric.
- □ Other *Architectural and/or Structural Plans* to fully describe proposed project, including, but not limited to:
 - **Stamped and Signed Structural Calculations** digital stamp and signature for electronic document submittals.
 - Gigned Truss Calculations (may be a deferred submittal).
 - **Energy Calculations** per California State Title 24.
 - □ Soils Reports required for new residential projects and residential additions where the addition is more than 50% of the existing floor area.
 - □ Fire Sprinkler Plans and Solar Plans are a deferred submittal.

FEES & PLANNING

ADDITIONAL APPROVALS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED PRIOR TO PERMIT ISSUANCE:

- From the Planning Division, Public Works Department, Parks and Recreation Department, LA County Fire Department and LA County
- When the project is in the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFHSZ) the design must comply with the California Residential Code (CRC) 2022 § R337.
- **School fees are required** to be paid for new habitable **spaces greater than 500 square feet**. Speak with staff for the appropriate form that must be taken to the school district prior to permit issuance.
- **NOTE:** A *separate grading plan check submittal* is required for all new construction projects and for some existing buildings where improvements being proposed will generate *50 cubic yards or more* of combined cut and fill. The grading plan shall be prepared, stamped, and signed by a California registered Civil Engineer. Prior to building permit issuance, the *Grading Plan must be approved, issued and a compaction report, survey report* and *pad certification must be submitted to the Building and Safety Division for approval.*
