



CITY CLERK'S CERTIFICATION THAT ONLY ONE PERSON HAS BEEN NOMINATED FOR EACH OF THE OFFICES OF MAYOR, CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT 2, AND CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT 4

I, Debra Black, City Clerk of the City of San Dimas, California, do hereby certify, pursuant to Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, to the following facts relating to the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026.

As of the close of the nomination period on March 6, 2026, only one person has been nominated for the office of Mayor, one person for the office of Councilmember, District 2, and one person for the office of Councilmember, District 4.

The persons so nominated are: Emmett G. Badar for Mayor, Eric Nakano for Councilmember, District 2, and Ryan A. Vienna for Councilmember, District 4.

Section 10229 of the Elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council for each of the elections of Mayor, District 2 Councilmember, and District 4 Councilmember:

- 1 Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated.
- 2 Appoint to the office any eligible elector (voter) if no one has been nominated.
- 3 Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

A notice of these facts will be published on March 11, 2026, in a newspaper of general circulation in the city pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code. After the fifth day following the date of publication, the City Council will meet to either make the appointment or direct an election to be held, for each office. The persons appointed, if any, shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.

If, by the 75th day before the municipal election, no person has been appointed to the office of Mayor, Councilmember District 2, or Councilmember District 4 pursuant to (1) or (2) above, then the election for the unappointed office or offices shall be held.

If the City Council makes an appointment pursuant to Section 10229, Elections Code, the City Clerk shall not accept for filing any statement of write-in candidacy which is submitted after the appointment is made.
