Under the provisions of the 1974 Housing and Community Development Act, The City of San Dimas will be receiving an estimated allocation of \$156,398 for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant Program Year along with a carryover unallocated balance of \$2,093 for a total of \$158,491

The public is invited to review the City of San Dimas's proposed projects to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan which identifies projected use of funds for the fiscal year (July 01, 2026 – June 30, 2027) for submission to the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development. The public can participate by providing comments for the purpose of obtaining citizen views on the final budget allocation for the programs listed below.

Eligible activities under the Community Development Block Grant program must meet one of the three national objectives to: 1) benefit low-in and moderate-income persons; 2) help eliminate slum and blight conditions; or 3) address an urgent need. The primary objective of the CDBG program continues to be the development of viable urban communities, by providing decent and safe housing and suitable living environments with expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income in the City of San Dimas.

The following programs proposed for the Fiscal Program Year 2026-2027 are:

Single Family Housing Rehabilitation \$138,491 (not to exceed 20% administrative costs)

Youth Scholarship Program \$ 10,000

Economic Development (Job creation) \$ 10,000 (Restaurant Attraction Program)

CDBG Program Year Total \$158,491
