<p><u>05-24-01- Speed Concern on E 2nd Street</u> <i>To review and consider Speed Hump Installation or option – installation of electronic warning signs</i></p>	<p>Comments/Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place speed feedback trailers on E 2nd Street from Iglesia to Walnut for one week collecting data in both directions. Request Sheriff's Department to provide additional enforcement in the area. This item will be continued.
<p><u>05-24-02- Speed Concern on Via Vaquero</u> <i>To review and consider changing speed limit from 25 mph limit to 15 mph limit on Via Vaquero</i></p>	<p>Comments/Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Request HOA (both in the area) to send residents reminder to reduce speed within the community. The City will be conducting a city-wide speed survey in the fall and streets in the complex will be evaluated. Add an advisory curve warning sign with 15 mph W1-1a along Via Vaquero in advance of the sharp curve in both directions. Place speed feedback trailers on W Via Vaquero for one week collecting data in both directions. Request Sheriff's Department to provide additional enforcement in the area This item will be continued.
<p><u>05-24-03- Shull Elementary - Amelia & Auto Center Dr</u> <i>To review and consider if a crosswalk attendant is warranted</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Safety concerns for students and parents from Large commercial trucks using center lane to avoid traffic backup and re-entering when in crosswalk/intersection Safety concerns for students and parent's vehicle blocking crosswalks Vehicles blocking intersection causing traffic on Auto Center/Allen and Amelia 	<p>Comments/Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact City of Glendora about additional School 25mph signage on southbound Amelia north of Auto Center Drive Request Sheriff's Department to provide additional enforcement in the area. Modify Traffic Signal Timing to Implement Leading pedestrian intervals after design by the City Traffic Engineer. Prioritize for implementation by next school year. Install signage for drop off only on west side of Amelia Ave from Auto Center Dr to south side of school property where parking is currently allowed. Signs to be consistent with those on south side of Auto Center Dr. (5-minute parking)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Install signage for drop off only on east side of Amelia Ave from Auto Center Dr to Placer Dr where parking is currently allowed. Signs to be consistent with those on south side of Auto Center Dr. west of Amelia Ave. (15-minute parking)</i> • <i>BUSD to send reminders to parents to be mindful of traffic regulations especially in school zones.</i> • <i>Work with the BUSD to improve traffic circulation for the onsite drop off/valet line.</i> • <i>School Crossing Guard Study performed by Traffic Engineer (May 1, 2024). The Crossing Guard Study concluded that pedestrian and vehicular counts did not satisfy requirements for a crossing guard.</i>
<p><u>05-24-04- Basilio and Juanita</u> <i>To review and consider adding additional safety features to this crosswalk</i></p>	<p>Comments/Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Replace Advance Warning Sign at 342 E Juanita.</i> • <i>Add red curb on the north side of Juanita at Basilio from the crosswalk to 15 ft west</i> • <i>Add red curb on east side of Basilio from the crosswalk to 15 ft south.</i> • <i>Trim tree located on the southside of Juanita Ave approximately 35 ft east of Basilio Ave (319 Basilio Ave).</i> • <i>Extend the drop off zone on north side of Juanita Avenue an additional 100 ft (in between the staff parking lot driveways) where parking is allowed.</i>
