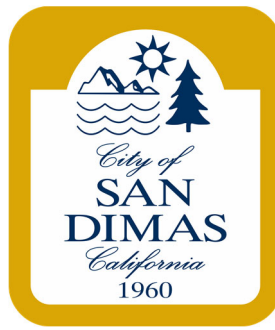

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:
 CC2024-02 LONE HILL AVE.
 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

You are cordially invited to find out more information about the project and its impact at the meeting scheduled for **Thursday, June 06, 2024 at 6:00 pm at San Dimas City Hall**. Members of the Public Works Department and the project's contractor, Vance Corporation, will provide a project overview, projected schedule, and will address any questions or concerns that may arise. Project improvements include replacement of dilapidated cross gutter, sidewalk repairs and installation of new accessible corner ramps, as well as rehabilitation of the asphalt pavement section that will provide an aesthetically pleasing, smoother and quieter street surface lasting for many years.

Construction is anticipated to start June 10, 2024 and will take approximately three months. During construction, there will be temporary traffic impacts and traffic may be restricted. This is necessary to provide adequate safety for passing traffic and to provide a smooth long-lasting finish. There will be times that driveway access is restricted. You will be notified in advance when this is necessary. The City and its Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience as much as possible. Your cooperation will help reduce the duration of the construction and will allow the City to restore normal traffic patterns more quickly.

While the construction impacts are temporary and inconvenient, these improvements are expected to last for decades to come. We would like to thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation during construction.
