# County:

- The Los Angeles County is announcing a "PPE-UP" by PPEUnite in Leimert Park this Saturday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at Hot and Cool Café. To receive free PPE supplies for your small business you must register <a href="here">here</a> until supplies last.
- The Los Angeles County <u>Health Order</u> was amended on December 9<sup>th</sup>, to reopen outdoor playgrounds to facilitate physically distanced personal health and wellness through outdoor exercise following the County Public Health Protocols for playgrounds. Playgrounds have been reopened at City Parks. Playgrounds located on schools that remain open for in-person instruction, and not accessible by the general public, may remain open and must follow County and State Protocols for Schools.
- Supervisor Hilda Solis announced the Pfizer vaccine has been approved and is expected shortly in Los Angeles County. The ICU capacity in Los Angeles County is 11.8% and the Southern California region is 10.1% which both are still below the 15% ICU capacity.
- Director of DHS Christina Ghaly, announced that 7,000 self-swab test kits have been processed since launching the at home test kit program last week. These kits are meant to be used right away. If you would like to request a kit visit, <u>Picture Genetics | At-home COVID-19 Test</u>.
