Local:

- Clean LA reminds us to flatten cardboard boxes before placing them in your recycling bin, this allows for more bin space as the holiday season brings more box packages.

- The Los Angeles County Health Department announced that about 6,000 frontline health workers will be vaccinated by Christmas and 10,000 total vaccinations by December 31st. This mass vaccination effort will begin, December 18th through three Los Angeles County Health Services hospitals; LAC+USC Medical Center, Olive View-UCLA Medical Center, and Harbor-UCLA Medical Center.
- Los Angeles County Department of Public Health issued an updated Health Officer **Isolation Order**. According this order, you must stay home and isolate yourself from others until you are no longer at risk from spreading COVID-19. If you have tested positive for a COVID-19 test or a healthcare provider clinically suspects symptoms of COVID-19 you are required to do the following:
 - Self-isolate
 - Tell your close contacts to self-quarantine if you have a positive test for COVID-19 and
