Latest Updates:

Local:

- While suspending parking and RV restrictions may be helpful to the community, we will continue to have parking enforcement for the following safety related activities:
 - Non-livable Recreational Vehicles (i.e. boats, ATV's unhitched trailer beds, etc.) parked in front or on-street;
 - Commercial vehicle parking in front yard or non-street;
 - Parking in fire lanes/red curbs, handicapped spaces, in front of fire hydrants, etc.
 - Parking in alleys;
 - Parking on unpaved surfaces
- CalOSBA is setting up the \$500 million grant program announced on November 30th by the Governor and the Legislature for grants up to \$25,000. Sign up [here](#) for updates and to receive information once the program is established.

State:

- Governor Newsom introduced the Regional Stay at Home Order dividing California into regions. Regions where ICU capacity falls below 15% availability will be placed into this Stay at Home order for three weeks. Southern California Region includes Los Angeles County, where it is predicted will reach the less 15% ICU availability within the next week.
- The Regional Stay at Home Order will be temporarily closing the following:
 - Bars
 - Wineries
 - Personal Services
 - Hair Salons/Barbershops
- Sectors that will remain open during the stay at home order in the region will include:
 - Schools that have received a waiver
 - Critical infrastructure
 - Retail (20% capacity to reduce exposure)
 - Restaurants (take-out and delivery)
