# City of San Dimas Office of the City Manager - Update October 2, 2020

### Latest Updates:

#### Local:

- Bobcat Fire update: the fire is approximately 79% contained at 114,901 acres. Firefighters observed minimal
  fire activity overnight and no fire growth. Isolated fire pockets are still present in the Mt. Wilson area on the
  northern slope, and firefighting priorities are to protect the observatory and communications sites there.
   Smoke from this area will remain visible and may make smoke plumes more prevalent in the afternoon as
  heavy fuels burn
- A Vote by Mail Drop Off Box has been installed at the San Dimas Library. If you are wary of mailing your ballot through the Post Office, another option is dropping your ballot in the Official Ballot Dropbox. Ballots will be retrieved at least twice a week during the first 20 days of the voting period. For the last ten days, ballots will be picked up at least every other day and potentially daily. All boxes will be secured at 8 pm on Election Day. Reminder: ballots will start to go out on Monday, October 5. Avoid waiting in line and vote early!
- Reminder: There will be a Household Hazardous Waste & E-Waste Roundup event tomorrow, October 3, from 9 am 3 pm at Duarte City Hall. Take this opportunity to dispose of old household cleaners, computers, microwaves, and more. For more information, click <u>HERE</u>
