The Vote Center will operate October 24, 2020 November 2, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. 7:00 p.m., and on November 3, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. –8:00 p.m. Every Los Angeles County resident is able to vote at any Vote Center in the Los Angeles County Area. For easy check in, bring the tear away portion of your sample ballot with the "Check-In Barcode".
