Latest Updates:

Local:

- Bobcat Fire update: the fire is approximately 88% contained at 115,758 acres. Firefighters observed minimal
 fire activity overnight and no fire growth in the Valley Forge and Falls Canyon areas north of Mt. Wilson.
 Commanders of the Bobcat Fire will be transitioning from California Interagency Incident Management Team
 11, to the Los Angeles National Forest to release resources and efforts to other critical needs throughout the
 state.
- National Night Out is tomorrow, Tuesday, October 6, featuring a First Responder Caravan from 4:30-5:30p and a Drive-Thru event from 5:30-7:00p located at Civic Center Plaza parking lot (245 E. Bonita Ave).

 - o October 24, 2020 November 2, 2020 10:00 am to 7:00 pm.
 - o November 3, 2020 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.
