Local:


- Bobcat Fire update: overnight crews were successful in increasing containment to 90%. The USFS
 emergency closure order for the Angeles National Forest expired last night. Please remember, BURN ZONES,
 remain CLOSED for public safety, fire recovery and restoration.

County:

- Great Plates program has been extended through November 8. Qualifying older adults can receive three(3) FREE home-delivered meals a day. Click here to apply, https://wdacs.lacounty.gov/greatplates/
- During the pandemic, U.S adults were more cautious to wash their hands after coughing, sneezing or blowing their nose. The CDC finds in their new study that 1 out of 4 people don't wash their hands after coughing, sneezing, or blowing their nose. Remember to wash your hands after:
 - o After using the bathroom
 - o Before and after preparing or eating food



- o After coughing, sneezing, or blowing your nose
- o Before and after touching your eyes, nose, or mouth
- o After going to a public place and touching a frequently touched surface
- o Before and after touch your mask.
- Fall has started and this is the time when temperatures start to slowly drop, with this comes the flu.
 COVID-19 has similar symptoms to the flu and therefore social distancing is important. Reminder that close contact is:
 - An individual who was within 6 feet of the infected person for at least 15 minutes
 - o An individual who has unprotected contact with the infected person. For example, being coughed or sneezed on, sharing utensils or saliva.

State:

- Governor Newsom announced the release of \$147 million in the fourth round of awards for HomeKey, California's nation-leading programs to purchase and rehabilitate housing- including hotels, motels vacant apartment buildings and other properties. Los Angeles County has been awarded more than \$39.5 million.
- The DMV has issued an extension through December 31, 2020 to ALL commercial driver's licenses, learner's permits, and endorsements expiring between March and December 31, 2020.
