- Free, same-day tests are now available for all LA County residents who have symptoms of COVID-19.
 Symptoms include fever, cough, and difficulty breathing. The following factors do not affect eligibility for a COVID-19 test:
 - o Immigration status
 - Insurance status
 - Age
 - Underlying health issues

- Los Angeles County, is partnering with Airbnb to provide free housing to up to 1,000 frontline workers fighting to contain the spread of COVID-19

- Governor Gavin Newsom signed an executive order to support California workers from large employers in the food sector industry impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic with two weeks of paid sick leave, filling a gap left by federal relief that had provided similar paid leave benefits for employers with fewer than 500 workers
 - The Executive Order also provides health and safety standards to increase worker and customer protection by permitting workers at food facilities to wash their hands every 30 minutes, or as needed, to increase proper sanitation measures
