### City of San Dimas Office of the City Manager – Update April 3, 2020

#### ***Latest Updates:***

- In alignment with current Federal, state, and local guidance for social distancing and to ensure health safety of its visitors, volunteers and employees, the Angeles National Forest will temporarily shut down portions of the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument and Los Angeles Gateway Ranger District, effective April 4, 2020 through April 30, 2020.

- Los Angeles County is ramping up COVID-19 testing sites, and opened three new locations today
  - Anyone interested in getting testing must first register on the screening website, <http://www.covid19.lacounty.gov/testing>
  - As of now, testing is still limited to residents in Los Angeles County who are in the most high-risk categories and most vulnerable
  - For those who prefer not to visit a drive-through test center, there are a limited number of tests available at a walk-in clinic at the Carbon Health-Echo Park location
