Latest Updates:

- The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) Governing Board recently approved \$15.4 million in funds from the California Air Resources Board for the Replace Your Ride program
 - As part of the program, residents living in the District can receive up to \$9,500 to purchase a
 newer and more fuel-efficient, including electric, vehicle at reduced cost, in exchange for
 retiring their older gas or diesel-burning vehicle. Applicants can also choose to scrap their older
 vehicle in exchange for a voucher that can be used for public transportation including Uber,
 Lyft, ridesharing and vanpooling

- Is your CalWORKs application pending and you usually work, but can't work now due to COVID-19?
 Ask about "Diversion' benefits instead of CalWORKs. Diversion provides up to \$5,000 for rent, utilities, or other needs while you start work again. Visit http://dpss.lacounty.gov/wps/portal/dpss for more information
- A modified Health Officer Order and directives for the reopening of additional businesses was issued
 yesterday with an effective date of today, June 12. The Health Officer Order allows for the following
 sectors to reopen once they implement the required protocols for infection control and distancing:
 - Gyms and fitness facilities
 - Pro-league arenas without live audiences
 - Day camps
 - Museums, galleries, zoos and aquariums
 - o Campgrounds, RV parks and outdoor recreation
 - Music, film and television production
 - Hotels for leisure travel
