## Latest Updates:

- Curious about the number of positive COVID-19 cases in San Dimas? The Los Angeles County Public
  Health website has a COVID-19 Surveillance Dashboard that includes information on the number of
  cases and deaths, testing information, demographics, hospitalizations, and more. Visit the dashboard

- Beginning tomorrow, July 17 at 6 am and continuing through Sunday, July 19 at 5 pm, SoCal Gas will be working at the Gladstone Street crossing, both day and night shifts, 24 hours a day
  - SoCal Gas will be performing construction operations for utility relocation underneath the Gladstone Street railroad crossing

- As cases and hospitalizations rise, many residents believe they need to get tested for COVID-19.
   However, Los Angeles County health officials stress that not everyone needs to be tested and emphasize the basic ways individuals and businesses can and should protect themselves from this virus
  - At this point in this rapidly-evolving crisis, it is essential to reserve testing for those who have a medical or public health reason for it. While Los Angeles County currently has enough testing supplies to meet the needs of those who need to be tested, the number of COVID-19 cases are on the rise here and throughout the country
  - Check with a health care provider if you think you need to get tested. It's always best to work
    with your health care professional to determine the kind of care you need—just as you would
    with any other health care concern
  - o Know your risk level. According to the latest Public Health guidance, the highest priority for testing should go to people with symptoms—including hospitalized patients, healthcare workers, first responders, employees and residents in group living settings, and people over 65 years old or with underlying health conditions that place them at higher risk of serious complications
