Latest Updates:

- As fire season approaches California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection recommends six "P's" to keep ready in case of immediate evacuation.
 - o People and pets
 - o Papers, phone numbers, important documents,
 - Prescriptions, vitamins, and eyeglasses
 - o Pictures, irreplaceable memorabilia
 - Personal computer hard drive and disks
 - o "Plastic" (credit cards, ATM cards) and cash
- The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health reminds us to avoid the three "C's" with people outside your household.
 - o Crowds
 - Confined Spaces
 - o Close Contact
- When caring for family positive for COVID-19, dirty laundry from a family member who has COVID-19 can be washed with other family items, but use the warmest water setting and dry items completely. Wear disposable gloves when handling dirty laundry from a person who is sick. Remove gloves and wash hands right away.

- Due to college students being forced to stay at home because of COVID-19, the City is still providing a special College Student Overnight Parking Permit. Below are the requirements for a Temporary College student Overnight Parking Permit that will be valid for the remainder of 2020:
 - o Must show proof of a current student ID
 - Must show proof of a current class curriculum (last semester OK)
 - o Must show proof of a valid San Dimas address
 - Must submit the following required vehicle information:
 - Vehicle Make
 - Vehicle Model
 - Vehicle License Plate Number
 - Vehicle Color
