Latest Updates:

- The State of California and the federal government are providing broad assistance to small businesses and employers impacted by COVID-19. This includes:
 - o Interest-free deferral of sales/use tax up to \$50,000 for businesses
 - o 90-day extension for businesses filing a return for less than \$1 million in taxes
 - o \$50 million in state funding for the Small Business Disaster Relief Loan Guarantee Program
 - Small Business Debt Relief for existing SBA borrowers
 - Federal small business stimulus programs like PPP and EIDL
 - o Federal tax credits to small businesses for COVID-19 employee paid leave
