- Employers can help prevent outbreaks in the workplace by reporting when you have three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases within 14 days
 - o Call 1 (888) 397-3993 or (213) 240-7821 to report these cases to LA County Public Health
 - Public Health will initiate a response which includes a Case Manager to guide the facility response and provide technical support, infection control guidance's, and site-specific control measures
