- Bobcat Fire update: The Bobcat Fire is now at 41,231 acres with a 3% containment. Firefighters are
  working on protecting Mt. Wilson and the foothill communities. The strategic burn operation will
  continue as weather conditions permit. The Closure Order for National Forests in Southern California
  has been extended to September 21
