#### Local:

- Bobcat Fire update: The Bobcat Fire is at 113,986 acres with 50% containment. A priority for today
  was the northeastern corner of the fire from Highway 2 to Big Rock Creek Road, where crews will be
  working to construct a direct handline. If this is not feasible, they will prepare for strategic firing. In the
  northwestern section of the fire, crews continue to build a direct handline from Highway 2 to Little
  Rock Reservoir. This task will take several days to accomplish
