<u>ADULTS:</u> Must be an individual over the age of 18 and experiencing homelessness in LA County

<u>YOUTH:</u> Must be between the ages of 16-24 and experiencing homelessness or housing instability in LA County.

<u>FAMILIES</u>: Household with minor child and experiencing homelessness or housing instability in LA County.

Do You Have a House, Apartment or Room to Rent?

You need to know about these rental assistance programs in LA County

Homeless Incentive Program (HIP):

- Receive up to one month's rent to hold a unit vacant.
- Enjoy the benefic of expedited housing quality standards inspections.
- Have a dedicated staff person to assist you with any tenant concerns.
- Receive qualified referrals to fill vacancies
- Receive reliable and timely rent payments
- Receive financial help with damages beyond normal wear and tear once tenant moves.

- Also called "Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool."
- Tenant pays 30% of income for rent, Housing for Health covers the rest.
- Guaranteed monthly rent payments from Housing for Health.
- Administered by the LA County Department of Health Services & Brilliant Corners.
- Tenant has case manager who can help if problems arise.

Rapid Re-Housing

- Graduated rent subsidy that decreases over time as the tenant's share of rent increases.
- Subsidy can start at 100% of rent and will reduce over time (usually limited to 6-12months.
- Administered countywide by various nonprofits with funding from the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA).
- Case Manager works with the tenant to increase income and is available to resolve any landlord-tenant issues that may arise.
