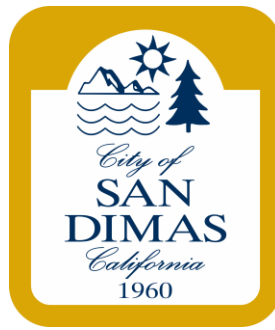

Dear Mr. Mirelez,

On behalf of the City of San Dimas, I hereby notify you that the City is proposing to adopt a new Specific Plan for a portion of the City's downtown. The purpose of this letter is to ensure that the Torres Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indians has the opportunity to consult with the City in accordance with California State Law.

Under California State Law, the Project is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the City will be preparing an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to evaluate the potential impacts of the Project. To inform you as to the location and scope of the Project, the CEQA Notice of Preparation is included as an attachment to this letter.

The Native American Resource Protection Act (Assembly Bill 52, Public Resources Code Section 21080.3.1) requires the City to notify California Native American Tribes of the decision to undertake the Project at the time the NOP is published and allows Tribes 30 days to request consultation.

If consultation with the City regarding this Project is desired, please respond to this letter within 30 days with a request in writing and identify a lead contact person.

Whether or not the Tribe wishes for consultation with the City, the City also welcomes comment from the Tribe as part of the scoping process described in the NOP.

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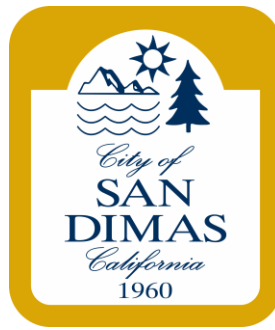

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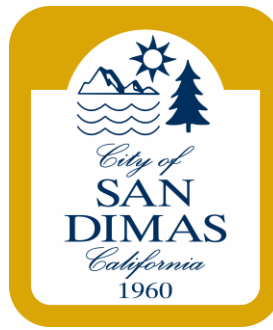

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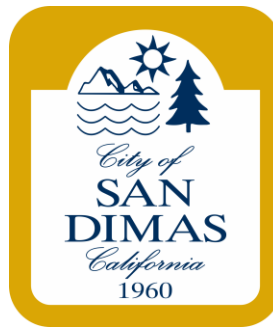
