Upon completion of Planning Department review and approval, the following items shall be provided with the submittal of an encroachment application:

- 1. Detailed construction drawings for the proposed facility.
- 2. A structural report, including engineering calculations for structure, foundation, when deemed necessary by the City.
- 3. Traffic Control Plans conforming to the California Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, when deemed necessary by the City.

4. A Traffic Study prepared by a California licensed traffic engineer for line-of-sight of any above ground structures, when deemed necessary by the City.
5. A completed Public Works Department Encroachment Permit Application.
