Application Checklist

Thank you for your interest in the City of San Dimas Parks and Recreation Department's Youth Assistance Scholarship Program (YASP). This scholarship is available to qualifying San Dimas youth who wish to participate in Kids Fun Club, Teen City, and other approved Parks and Recreation programs.

To comply with the requirements of our funding agency, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), eligibility must be verified for all families applying to the program. Please submit all required documentation listed below. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

Income Eligibility Documentation

Please provide documentation for ALL sources of income for ALL parents/guardians in the household:

- Three (3) current and consecutive pay stubs
 - For self-employed households: Three (3) months of bank statements
 - Current public assistance award letter(s), if applicable (SSI, EDD, TANF, etc.)
 - If there is no earned income (for example, the household only receives public assistance and/or child support), complete and sign the attached No Earned Income Statement Form
 - Most recent Federal and State income tax returns for each employed adult in the household

Families Receiving Government Assistance

Please provide documentation showing current enrollment in one of the following programs:

- Cash Aid

Examples of acceptable documentation include: • Notice of Action

- Receipt of Aid
 - Verification of Benefits

Residency Verification

Proof of residency within the City of San Dimas is required.

Current rental agreement or lease

OR

Current utility bill (gas, water, or electric) showing the applicant's name and address

Family Size Verification

If your child(ren) are not listed on your tax return, please provide birth certificates to verify household size.

Additional Required Documents

Completed Immigration Status Declaration (Executive Order 14218) and supporting documentation

Completed activity registration form for each child applying for scholarship assistance

California Driver's License or California Identification Card for each adult listed on the application

Note: The address on the application must match the address on the identification provided.

Important Information

- Scholarship funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Scholarship funds may not be used toward program shirts, uniforms, or excursions/field trips.
 - The scholarship is non-transferable.
 - If a participant withdraws or does not attend, scholarship funds will not be credited back to the applicant's account.
