

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIMAS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **October 14, 2025** the City Council of the City of San Dimas, California, introduced an Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIMAS, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING MUNICIPAL CODE TEXT AMENDMENT 25-05, A CITY-INITIATED MUNICIPAL CODE TEXT AMENDMENT TO AMEND TITLE 18 ZONING, TO ELIMINATE CHAPTER 18.188 EXPLOSIVES FROM THE CODE IN ITS ENTIRETY

The proposed Ordinance (Ordinance No. 1332) amends Title 18 of the San Dimas Municipal Code to delete Chapter 18.188 in its entirety. Chapter 18.188, with provides for permitting requirements for explosives and was adopted in 1961, is no longer applicable. Federal and state agencies are responsible for regulating the handling, storage and use of explosives and Chapter 18.188 has been superseded by federal and state requirements.

The City Council will conduct a second reading and consider the adoption of Ordinance No. 1332 on October 28, 2025.
