Existing “Stop” (R1-1) and “Stop Ahead” (W3-1) signs are visible and comply with regulatory standards.</li> <li>• Review of the collision history does not indicate a pattern for lack of visibility.</li> <li>• Request additional enforcement from San Dimas Sheriff’s Station during peak travel periods.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>01-25-02 Puente St &amp; Avenida Monte Vista/ Puente St &amp; Via Esperanza intersection concerns</u></b>  <i>Request from Resident, review traffic intersection concern.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff to request trees to be trimmed.</li> <li>• Staff confirmed the striping was refreshed recently and visible. Existing “Stop” (R1-1) and “Stop Ahead” (W3-1) signs comply with regulatory standards.</li> <li>• Review of the collision history does not indicate a pattern for lack of visibility.</li> <li>• Request additional enforcement from San Dimas Sheriff’s Station during 9:30am-10:00am &amp; 7:00pm in the evenings.</li> </ul>

<p><b><u>01-25-04 W Gladstone Avenue Regarding Buses &amp; Trucks</u></b>  <i>Request from Resident, review traffic concern regarding buses and trucks traveling on Gladstone Avenue</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff has met and confirmed with Foothill Transit, and no buses will be traveling or detouring on Gladstone Avenue. Staff working with Foothill Transit for alternative routes that align with the City’s designated truck routes.</li> <li>• Staff to add truck weight restriction sign at Gladstone Ave and San Dimas Ave intersection.</li> <li>• Staff to ask for additional enforcement from San Dimas Sheriff’s Department.</li> </ul>

<p><u><b>09-24-05 Ekstrand Elementary</b></u> Request by BUSD, to review intersection of Juanita and Basilio due to near miss of student in crosswalk.</p>	<p><b>Comment/Recommendations:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff to send proposed exhibit plans to Fire &amp; Sheriff Department for review and approval.</li> <li>• Traffic Engineer to provide exception to policy regarding collector streets after receiving feedback from Fire and Sheriff Department.</li> <li>• Once plans and exception to speed hump policy have been reviewed, this item will be brought to City Council for approval and funding.</li> </ul>
